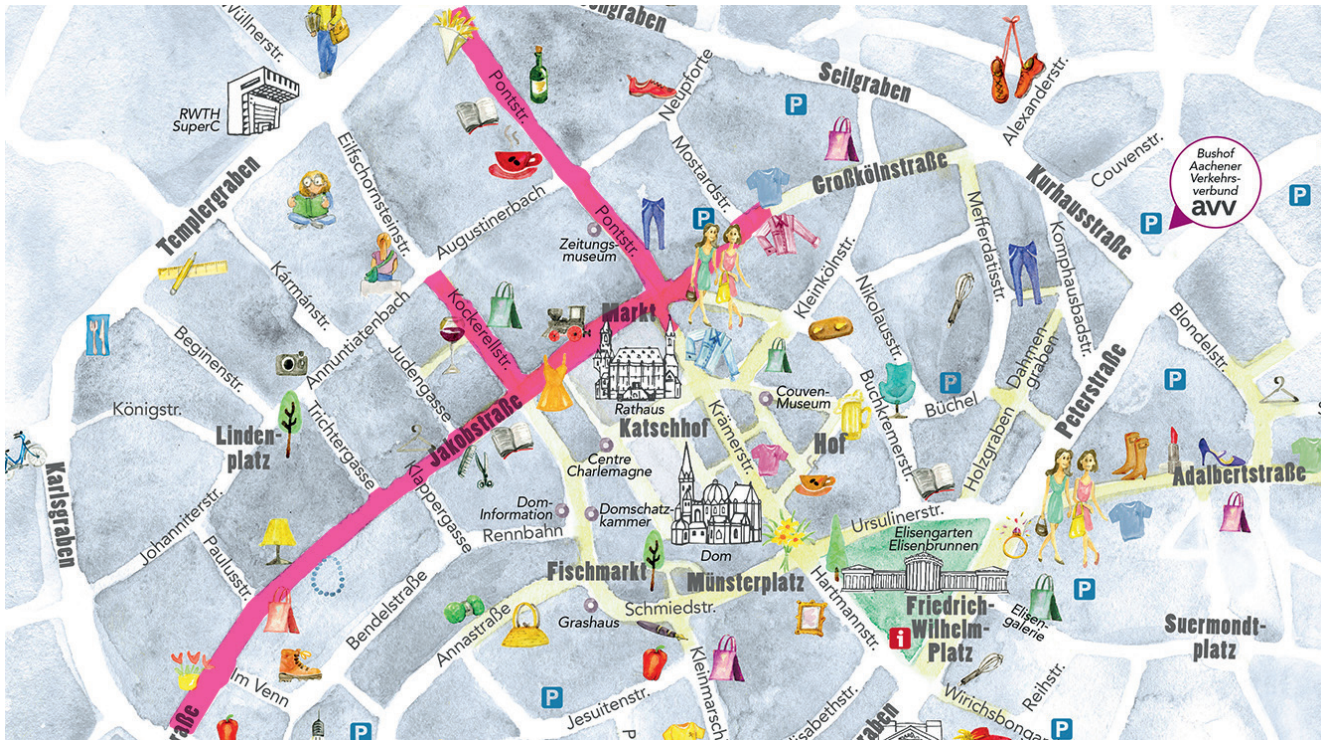


ROUTE 1 – AROUND THE TOWN HALL
